HELEN BURGESS WEBB

HELEN BURGESS WEBB was born August 23, 1912 in Arlington, Virginia. She attended Arlington County Schools for her early education and Armstrong High School in Washington, DC.

She accepted Jesus as her Savior at the age of 11 and joined the Mt. Salvation Baptist Church in Arlington, Virginia where she became a well-respected member and faithfully served for over 70 years. She served in several capacities that include: Assistant Church Clerk, Chairperson of Condolences, President of the Senior Usher Board and membership in the Voices of Harmony and the Young Ladies Never Idle Ministry, where she served as secretary for over 50 years. In 1985 she was appointed to the Deaconess Board in which she actively served with dignity and humility.

Deaconess Helen Webb was well known for her unique ability to bless others at many churches and religious gatherings, by sharing her favorite religious poems with grace and great conviction.

Deaconess Webb became affiliated with the Northern Virginia Baptist Association, Inc. and was faithful in supporting the activities sponsored by the Association for many years. She enjoyed fellowshiping with the Women's Auxiliary where she gained life-long Christian friends. She co-chaired the Credentials Committee, and wholeheartedly supported children in their various activities.

Deaconess Helen Webb was married to Earnest E. Webb on August 15, 1935. She transitioned on October 14, 1999. Because of her love for the Women's Auxiliary, she bequeathed them \$10,000. A decision was made to use this money to establish the Helen B. Webb Scholarship.

CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP

Applicants applying for the Helen B. Webb Scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Must be a member** of a church that is a member of the Northern Virginia Baptist Association, Inc.
- 2. Must be** a high school graduating senior.
- 3. Must be** accepted to a school of higher education—university, 4-year college, community college, or technical college.
- 4. Each application will be reviewed and recipients'** selection will be based on: academic achievement; financial need; participation in their church, school, and community; a written essay; and three letters of recommendation.
- 5. Must pay close attention** to follow the instructions for the essay formatting and recommendation letter requirements.
- 6. Complete** the entire scholarship application package and submit the official school transcript by email.
- 7. Submit** the completed application by the **June 23, 2025 DEADLINE**.

The student's completed application; includes the completed application, written essay, three recommendation letters, and official transcript (PDF format) and should be emailed directly to the Scholarship Chair at HelenBWebbscholarship@gmail.com by 11:59 PM by June 23, 2025. The student's **school representative** should email the official transcript **directly to the Scholarship Committee Chair at HelenBWebbscholarship@gmail.com by the deadline.** **Resumes are not acceptable.**

ESSAY typewritten (double spaced, minimum/maximum one-page, normal margins, Times New Roman) **SUBJECT:** *"My Career Goal and How I Am Going to Achieve It" or "A Challenge I Overcame and What I Learned from It."* One of these titles must be at the top of your essay. Essays without a title and on any other topic will be eliminated.

B. An OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT of your grades. Must be a PDF & EMAILED **directly** from your school counselor.

C. THREE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATIONS: (Only one letter from each category will be accepted, and the letter must be no more than three months old)

1. **CHURCH LEADER** (i.e., Pastor, Youth Minister, Sunday School Teacher, Deacon, Deaconess, or Youth Advisor, etc.).
2. **SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR** (i.e., Guidance Counselor, Principal, or Assistant Principal).
3. **SCHOOL FACULTY** (i.e., Teacher, Coach).
4. **EMPLOYER** (Full-time, Part-time, Nonprofit)

If selected, the college address and student ID number will be required within one week after decision letter has been sent in order to release the scholarship funds.

XI. Students and parents will receive the notification of the scholarship decision in July. In the event that the scholarship recipient cannot attend the Helen B. Webb Scholarship and Recognition Luncheon scheduled on August 23, 2025 at 12 noon, the Scholarship Committee requests that a representative attend the Luncheon to accept the scholarship award on behalf of the student. The registration and payment form for attending the Scholarship and Recognition Luncheon, will be sent with the decision letter in July.
